

Automation Lifecycle Management 5.0 – July 2023

This release note is for the 5.0 release of Blue Prism® Automation Lifecycle Management.



SS&C | Blue Prism ALM 5.0 is only available in Blue Prism Cloud – it is not available as an on-premises solution. Please refer to the roadmap for more information on the planned versions of the Blue Prism Hub platform and the plugins.

Removal of the dependency between Hub and its plugins

Version 5.0 brings a fundamental change to the relationship between the individual plugins and Blue Prism Hub. Although Blue Prism Hub will continue to host the plugins, changes have been made to remove or reduce the level of dependency, with the view to enable installing and upgrading of future plugins without the need to upgrade the whole of Hub 5.0 and the other plugins.
